Nursery schools provide places for children aged 18 months to 6 years. Nursery schools in Gardabaer are open from 07:30 to 18:00. They are run by specially trained staff in accordance with the Nursery Schools Act No 78/1994 and the development curriculum for nursery schools issued by the Ministry of Education. The main aim of the legislation is to give children the opportunity to receive guidance from staff who are specially trained in child development and who will assist the children as they progress individually and socially. The staff will inform parents if they feel that a child is not following normal developmental patterns. Parents will always be consulted before any action is taken. Nursery school staff provide support for parents as they bring up their children.
